-Fantasy Ad Finem- I want to expand the current "unofficial" fantasy league that we have (which is 12 teams) and make it an official fantasy football league for us. The new league would be 40 teams. I emailed out a document that lists the format (I will also attach it in this meeting)

...essentially we break 40 fantasy football teams into 4 divisions of 10 teams. Of those only 1 is our grand champion...there will be 3 first place winners, and 4 2nd place winners. The buy in for the league is \$25. With 40 participants that would give a prize pool of \$1000. However if we supplement the prize pool with free membership kits and free store gift cards than we can net a decent amount to donate to The Bernadine Center.So if we were to donate (4) 2024 Membership Kits+ \$700 in Shop Gift Cards (Almost everything has been paid off in the store) than we would, in theory, be able to donate around \$650 to the bernadine center.
